HIGH FIVE® is Canada's only comprehensive quality standard for organizations providing recreation and sport programs to children aged 6 to 12.



Our Vision

Through sustained involvement in quality recreation and sport activities, all children aged 6 to 12 years are experiencing healthy development.



Principles of Healthy Child Development

The HIGH FIVE[®] standard is based on research that a child's development is best supported when they are in a program that provides them with:

5 Principles of Healthy Child Development:

- ★ a caring adult
- ★ play
- ★ friends
- ★ mastery
- ★ participation



Design Guidelines

HIGH FIVE[®] also recognizes three design guidelines as a non-negotiable foundation on which the principles grow and develop. These are:

3 Design Guidelines:

- ★ safe
- ★ diverse and unique
- ★ developmentally appropriate



HIGH FIVE[®] Mission

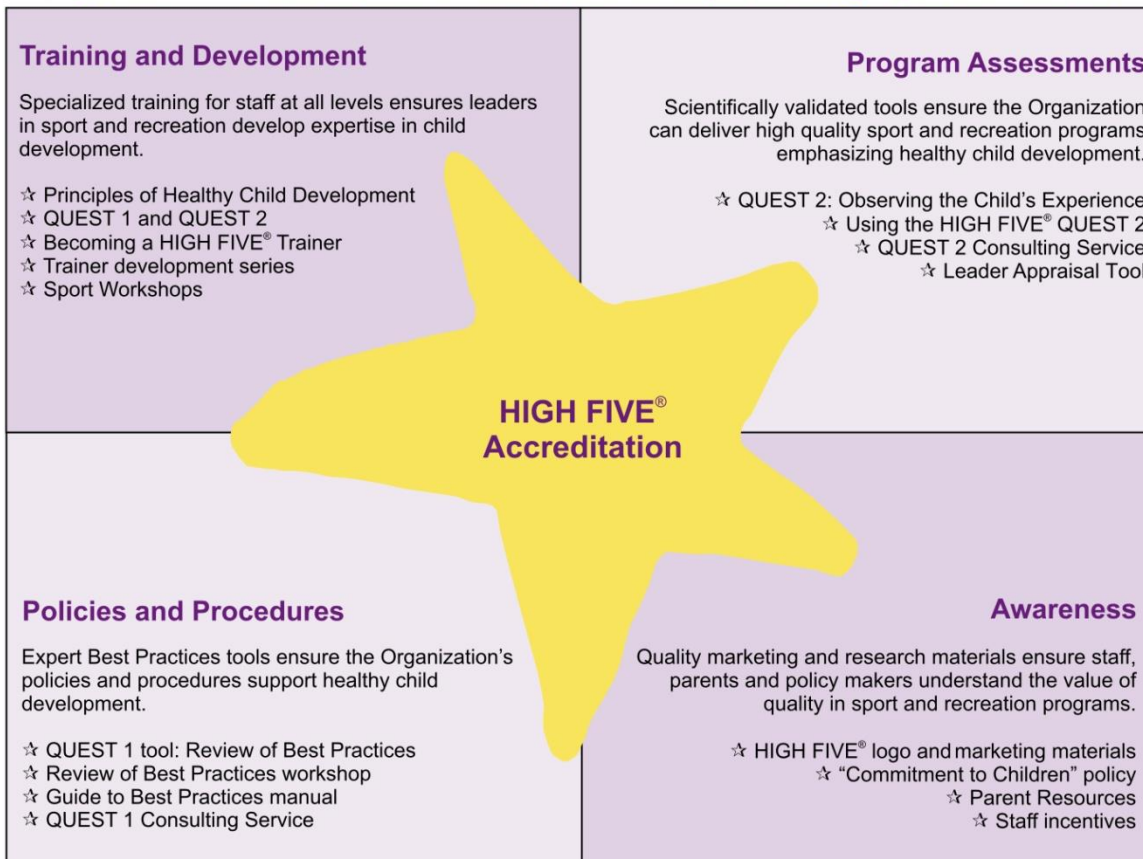
HIGH FIVE[®] is a framework committed to assisting children along the path of healthy development through:

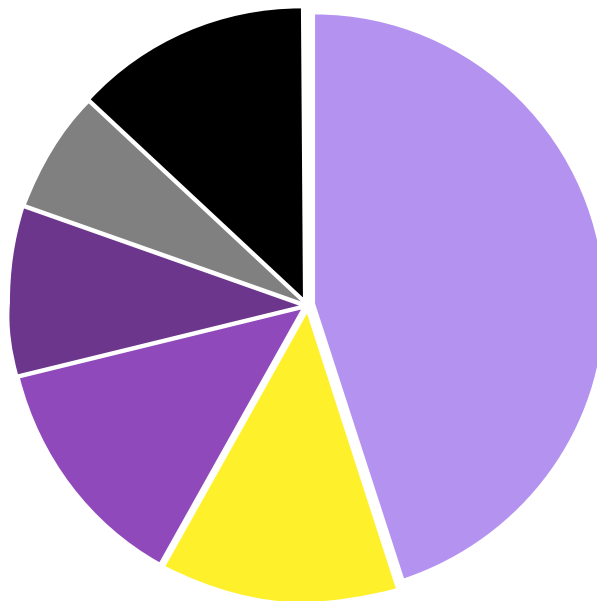
