

## QUEST 1 – Reviewing Best Practices Outline

*This 3 hour course assists organizations in assessing the extent to which their policies and procedures support healthy child development. The accompanying tool, Guide to Best Practices, is a resource manual that helps to standardize and strengthen children's programs. This course is generally recommended for directors and managers.*
