



From June 8th – 12th forty students from throughout B.C. and instruction staff assembled at the Chilcoot Conference Centre on Silver Star Mountain for the 37th Leisure Development Course. Over the four day instruction period students were subjected to in–depth study in the areas of Community Development; Open Space Planning; Risk Management; and Facility Design. At the completion of the learning period students are assigned correspondence

assignments in each of the respective topic areas for completion and grading. The Leisure Development Course is a unique three year certificate–granting program designed for those employed and/or interested in the field of parks, recreation and culture.
