Please note, we will ONLY accept answers to the nomination questions in the online form. Please do not send us answers to these questions in any other format, as they will not be accepted.

In addition to the questions listed below, you will be asked to provide:

- **Contact information of the Nominee**
- **Contact information of Two (2) Nominators**
- At least **two (2) Letters of Impact** from BCRPA members (maximum 2 pages each in PDF, no larger than 10 MBs).
- **OPTIONAL: You are welcome to attach up to 5 supporting documents**, which may include newspaper clippings, photos, and additional letters, etc.
 - Accepted file formats include jpg, jpeg, tiff, png, eps, pdf
 - Each file must not exceed 10 MBs
 - Letters should not exceed 2 pages
- You will also be asked to complete a **photography release form** (to be completed by the copyright holder) and an **application release form**. Both forms are integrated into the online nomination form
